IRG-Tetra Tech Joint Venture Wins \$6 M USAID Tsunami Warning System Project

WASHINGTON, Aug. 9 /PRNewswire/ -- International Resources Group (IRG) and Tetra Tech, Inc. today announced that the United States Agency for International Development has selected the joint venture to support the development of an Indian Ocean Tsunami Warning System.
